



# GUIDELINES

## FOR THE POSITION PAPER (PP)

### A) General information about the delegate and their delegation:

- Full name of the event: "GRAND International".
- Full name of the committee and acronym in capital letters.
- Full official name of the country or delegation. To consult the official names according to the United Nations, visit:  
<https://www.un.org/es/about-us/member-states>.
- List of the full names of the topics.
- Name of the delegate.
- Include: age, name, educational institution, grade level.
- Include: Capital of the delegation, current head of state or government, and form of government.

### B) Economic, social and cultural situation:

- Description of the current economic situation of the country or entity represented.
- Key economic indicators (GDP, inflation, unemployment).
- Important economic sectors.
- **Social situation:** Current social challenges (poverty, inequality, education, etc.) and implemented social policies.
- **Cultural situation:** Relevant cultural characteristics and cultural and tourist heritage.

### C) Topic Development (for each topic):

- **Block 1.** Background to the event.
- **Block 2.** The country's foreign and domestic policy regarding the event.
- **Block 3.** Proposals focused on addressing the event.

## FOR THE POSITION PAPER (PP)

### D) Additional details:

- Any additional information the delegate considers relevant to their position or country.
- Specific initiatives or proposals to address global or regional challenges.

### E) References:

- You must cite each of your statements, directly or indirectly, using reliable and official sources such as the United Nations (and its agencies), government websites, and civil society organizations.
- You must include your references at the end of the document in APA 7th edition format (they will not count toward the word count). Failure to cite or reference constitutes **plagiarism!**

### Form and Style Guidelines

- **Times New Roman, Arial, or Poppins** font, size 14 for titles and 12 for body text.
- Maximum 1500 words total without truncating references (*500 for the introduction, 500 for the first section, and 500 for the second*). **No more space allowed!**
- Double-spaced (2.0).
- One-inch margins on all sides (2.54 cm/1 in).
- APA 7th edition bibliographic references
- APA 7th edition quotations
- Justified alignment
